SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear colleagues,

We are pleased to contact you again to communicate the main contents, deadline for abstract submission and registration fees of the Third Paleopathology Association Meeting in South America (PAMinSA III). As it was mentioned in the First Announcement, the PAMinSA III will take place in Necochea (Argentina) from October 14-16, 2009.

PRESENTATION MODALITIES:

Presentations are structured in three modalities: Symposia, Podium Presentations and Posters.

Symposia are directed to works of synthesis that discuss a specific topic. Fifteen minutes for exposition and five minutes for questions and discussion will be granted for these presentations. The following Symposia are proposed:

Symposium 1: Ecology Adaptations and Human Health

Coordinator: Dr. Adauto Araujo (Brazil) and Dr. Karl Reinhard (USA)

The health of current and past human populations has an intimate association with environment, including other non-human species. Paleoparasitological and paleoenvironmental studies allow incorporating relevant information for the reconstruction of biological and social scenarios in which human populations lived.

Symposium 2: Interactions between Paleopathology and Forensic Sciences.

Coordinators: Dra. Mercedes Salado Puerto (Argentina) and Dr. Conrado Rodríguez Martín (Spain)

These disciplines share fields of research and interaction. Moreover, the results in one influence and open new paths in the other, although this relationship is not always acknowledged. In this Symposium we intend to create a place to debate and communicate new information about the integration of these two areas of research.

Symposia 3: New Methods in Paleopathology

Coordinators: Dra. Alena Iñiguez (Brazil) and Dr. José Napoli (Argentina)

In the last few decades, new methodologies like molecular biology, image diagnosis techniques, advances in histopathology and paleoparasitology have shown their increasing potential to enrich the paleopathological studies of skeletons and mummified remains. This Symposium aims at the creation of a place for the presentation and discussion of the scopes, limitations and the potential of these and other new methodologies, which have just recently begun to be applied in South American Paleopathology.

Symposium 4: Health at the moment of Native-European Contact in America.

Coordinators: Dra. Della Collins Cook (USA) and Dra. Claudia Rodrigues-Carvalho (Brazil)

The study of the impact of Native-European contact in America and their consequences for human populations' life styles and health have been subject of considerable attention in Paleopathology. This Symposium seeks to generate a special space to discuss new results and integrate

expectations about the health patterns observed before, during and after the contact in different regions of America and Europe.

Podium Presentations are planned for case studies about skeletal series in archaeological and historical contexts, or synthesis works about topics not included in symposia. Allotted time for these expositions will be of 15 minutes and 5 minutes for questions and discussion.

Posters are suggested for those works presenting case studies of a single skeleton, news about techniques, methodologies, diagnosis criteria or to bring up to date investigations under way. Posters recommended dimensions are 85 cm. width and 120 cm length. Posters must be delivered the day of the beginning of PAMinSA III by the author/s or a person in charge and will be exposed during the entire meeting. Special sessions will be dedicated for posters, allowing the authors to respond questions of colleagues.

Finally, three **Conferences** will be presented during the Meeting, lectured by recognized researchers that will be confirmed in our next announcement.

The call for papers in any of the modalities is open to all the researchers interested in the topics. The Scientific Committee –and the coordinators of Symposia, in the case of this kind of presentation- will be responsible of the evaluation of the abstracts submitted and might suggest changes in the chosen modality of presentation, should they find it pertinent. Due to time constraints, only two works per author will be accepted in Symposia and Podium Presentation, either as first (or sole) author or as co-author. On the contrary, there will not be restrictions to the number of posters presented by each author.

Final information will be checked when receiving your abstract/s. Once you have completed the form and sent it, you will receive a **pre-registration number** by e-mail. Please **keep this number** as it will be required for you to present it, both when you **send your abstract/s** and when you **pay for the Meeting fee**.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Deadline for abstract submission is **June 15, 2009**. From this date on, the members of the Scientific Committee and Symposia coordinators will evaluate each abstract. **Later arrivals will not be accepted**. Immediately after the submission of the abstract, each author will receive a written confirmation. In case of not receiving such a confirmation, we recommend writing to the organizers and resending the abstract. The Local Organizing Committee will send a notification of the Scientific Committee's decision.

Please, prepare your abstract either in English or in Spanish. The body of the abstract should contain no more than 2000 characters with spaces, including:

- **title** (in capitals);
- **authors** with addresses/affiliations;
- **text** including **aims** and **objectives** of presentation, **material** and **methods**, brief **results** and **discussion**;
- **five key words** at the end of the text.
- A maximum of **two** references embedded in the text is allowed but no figures/tables.

Finally, you should specify at the end of the abstract the **presentation modality** chosen (in case of being a symposium, please specify its name) and the **pre-registration number** given when submitting the on line pre-registration form.

REGISTRATION FEES AND PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Registration fees are in the following chart. Discount fees for Latinamerican's researchers and students were considered in order to compensate for the difference in the value of South American countries currency in relation to US dollar and Euro. Thus, we intend to promote the participation of South American colleagues to encourage the growth of paleopathology in this region.
